- Catholic Charities of Colorado has requested help with cooking breakfast for national bicycling event on July 6th in Castle Rock.
- A motion was made to donate \$400 to a friend of Jim Butler who is in serious medical condition. Seconded and passed unanimously.
- The Church is going to purchase mats for the kitchen. John Park is able to purchase the mats through Sysco for \$125 each. Motion to spend up to \$500 for purchase of the mats which was seconded. Upon discussion, Gurney Thompson indicated he may be able to get through his company for better price. The motion was tabled to authorize spending up to \$500 unless Gurney can get better deal.
